What is Inside Out Camps?

Inside Out Camps is a residential summer camp purposely created to give 12-15 year olds a much needed 'time out' from their norms and daily routines to learn and develop essential life skills in an experience-based environment.

Incorporating a host of activities and workshops, Inside Out Camps is designed to challenge its participants creatively, physically and mentally. The personal rewards and benefits for the young individuals who experience an Inside Out Camp can be truly life-changing.

The camps take place in <u>St Columba's College</u> at the foot of the Dublin mountains and will run from Monday 30th June to Friday 4th July and Monday 7th July to Friday 11th July 2025.

The Junior Leadership Programme

This year, we are offering a new, unique "Junior Leadership Programme" to those who have completed an Inside Out camp in the last 3 years and are 16 years of age or older.

The Junior Leadership Programme is designed for enthusiastic young adults to gain invaluable experience in a dynamic multi-activity environment.

At the end of the programme, Junior Leaders will be awarded a certificate of completion along with a monetary reward.

Please note that the Junior Leadership Programme does not include residential accommodation. All Junior Leaders will be asked to make there way to and from St Columba's College for the duration of the camp.

Programme Schedule and Outline

Camp activities commence at 9am and finish around 9.30pm daily. Junior Leaders are requested to be onsite for the duration of these activities (approx. 15 minutes before the beginning of the first activity) however their participation will be managed in order to ensure they have adequate break times and will not be 'on duty' throughout. The Junior Leadership Programme Lead should be made aware if participants need to start later or finish earlier on a given day to ensure efficient running of the programme.

During the programme, Junior Leaders will gain experience and learnings in the fields of:

- 1. **Session planning** understand and upskill in preparation and organisational skills.
- 2. **Collaboration and Workplace Adaptability** assisting coaches in the day-to-day activities of camp.
- 3. **Communication** how Inside Out coaches communicate in order to facilitate the day-to-day life of camp.
- 4. What it takes to be a leader at Inside Out understanding the commitment needed to push for the best experience for campers.
- 5. **Accountability and Responsibility** ensuring that roles and responsibilities of each day are completed.

The Leadership program will be overseen by our Operations Director Hillary Nets in conjunction with our Leadership Director Alex Kiernan. Leaders selected for this programme will report to Alex for any issues/problems which have occurred.

Junior Leaders we are looking for should display the skills of communication, decision – making and leadership as well as possessing characteristics of having an active mindset along with being enthusiastic, energetic and flexible.
